What is a Capital Campaign?

A Capital Campaign is a church project that seeks pledged donations from members to be used for much needed projects in a parish.

Why are we having another Capital Campaign?

Our last Capital Campaign ended in 2007 and a new campaign is needed to pay down debts and to expand current ministries and provide much needed maintenance on the church and facilities.

What happens to previous campaign obligations?

For those making new pledges, pledges from all previous campaigns cease.

Will I be pressured to pledge?

No. Participation in the campaign and how much you give will be entirely up to you. All members and guests will be given the opportunity to contribute if they wish to do so.

How may I prepare to participate?

Allow God to speak to your heart through prayer. The Sacred Scriptures say, "Give in the measure that you have received" and "God is never outdone in generosity."



If I can't give a large amount, does my pledge really matter?

Absolutely! All pledges matter, regardless of amount, because as we all participate according to our ability, God multiplies our giving.

When are we expected to give the amount pledged?

Pledge cards will be turned in on Commitment Weekend, March 28-29th and pledges will begin to be received shortly thereafter. Pledges can be spaced out over 3 years.

What forms of contributions will be accepted?

Contributions can be made by cash or check in a weekly or monthly envelope. Other forms of contributions can include transference of title to marketable stocks, bonds, real estate, etc.

May I update my commitment after celebration Sunday?
